Beer is the world's oldest and most widely consumed alcoholic beverage. The basics of brewing beer are shared across national and cultural boundaries, possibly dating back to the early Neolithic or 9000 BC. Beer was spread through Europe by Germanic and Celtic tribes as far back as 3000 BC, The product that the early Europeans drank might not be recognized as beer by most people today

Beers are commonly categorised into two main types—the globally popular pale lagers, and the regionally distinct ales, which are further categorised into other varieties such as pale ale, stout and brown ale.

## DRAUGHT BEER & CYDER

<b>BASS PALE ALE</b>	\$ 4.95	\$ 2.75

The most famous English ale in the world, and has been brewed in Burton, England since 1777. It is a full-flavoured ale that is still brewed to an original recipe.

A popular Irish dry stout that originated in the brewery of Arthur Guinness at St. James's Gate, Dublin. A distinctive feature is the burnt flavour which is derived from the use of roasted barley

A refreshing, smooth and sessionable beer. It is renowned for its golden colour, full-bodied flavour and malty, morish taste with smooth, tight creamy head. Brewed in Manchester since 1778,

A fine, golden pilsner lager, originally brewed as a Christmas beer in Leuven, Belgium. It is a beer that manages to balance a fuller flavour with a clean crisp taste to make it an exceptional premium lager.

Beck's German pilsner lager, brewed in accordance with the Reinheitsgebot, German purity law of 1516, using only four ingredients; water, malted-barley, hops and yeast. It is this blend of hops that give the beer it's distinctively crisp and full-flavoured taste

Consisting of a Half Pint of Bass Pale Ale and Half a Pint of Guinness. The precise combination of Bass Pale Ale and stout resulted in a flavour like no other. Its popularity quickly spread throughout Britain and Ireland.

<b>SPITFIRE REAL ALE</b>	\$5.75

Originally produced in 1990 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Battle of Britain, Spitfire has lingering malt and hop flavours with a well balanced lasting aftertaste.

Has a full, smooth flavour and is very easy to drink. Its rich, amber colour and superb fruity aromas are complemented by a delicious blend of malty tastes

#### MAGNERS ORIGINAL CIDER \$5.95

Crafted from a unique blend of 17 varieties of apples sourced from their own orchards in Clonmel County, Tipperary. Magners is patiently vat matured to a crisp, refreshing taste.

#### MAGNERS PEAR CIDER \$5.95

This pear cider is made from 100% premium quality pears. It is slowly fermented, then cold filtered to eliminate any impurities, making it fresher, fruitier and fuller flavoured

#### PERONI \$4.75

An intensely crisp and refreshing lager with an unmistakable touch of Italian style. Brewed in Italy to the original recipe conceived and launched in 1963. Crisp and lightly sparkling, its unique taste is refreshing and dry with a clear-cut, clean character

#### HOEGAARDEN \$ 5.25

A white beer which is brewed in Belgium. Its taste comes from ingredients added during the brewing process, such as - wheat, coriander and Curacao orange peels. The pale, cloudy appearance is due to an additional second fermentation in the bottle.

#### STAROPRAMEN \$ 4.75

The pride of Prague, Staropramen appeals to consumers' search for authenticity and superior quality. This beer features a full-bodied, pleasantly balanced taste with a gently bitter epilogue.

#### KONIG PILSNER 4.95

A medium golden colour German Pilsner with exceptional clarity. König has the typical aroma of a Pilsner only with an additional dose of biscuity malt that gives this an unusually sweet bread aroma.

#### GROLSCH \$ 5.95

With a sophisticated, bright golden pour and a stable white head, this beer is the epitome of a world class European lager. Subtle hop notes and a mild maltiness give way to a clean finish of this Dutch Master piece

#### CORONA \$4.75

This bright golden coloured Mexican lager beer pours brilliantly clear. The beer tastes clean and refreshing with some mild cereal notes and some delicate hop bitterness. The flavour of Corona is complimented with a slice of fresh lime

#### KING FISHER \$5.95

First brewed in 1915, Kingfisher is today the world's - and Britain's - best selling Indian lager. Kingfisher has a uniquely full and hoppy taste. It is a clean, refreshing lager, bursting with hops, filling the mouth with citrus and herbs in an intensity of flavour, which is not overwhelmed by hot and spicy food.

#### TSINGTOA \$4.75
